The Liberal Democrats and the ABC

In the process of assessing candidates in Macquarie for our branch's voting guide (see page 2), research was undertaken regarding the respective parties' stated policies, voting records and public statements regarding the ABC and SBS. This was in addition to assessing replies to our candidate questionnaire.

The Liberal Democrats' "Freedom Manifesto" (https://www.ldp.org.au/freedom) is their party's suite of policies for the 2022 election. The "Debt and Deficit" section contains the following policy on funding of public broadcasting, which is presented here verbatim for your edification:

Defund the ABC & SBS. Let the ABC & SBS pay their own way through advertising, subscriptions and donations from their adoring fans.

It should be noted that no acknowledgement of our candidate questionnaire was received from the Liberal-Democrat candidate, James Jackson.

Blue Mountains Branch's "Vote to Support Your ABC" voting guide

The process for assessing each candidate's level of support for the ABC is explained on the previous page.

None of the candidates in the "No support or no response" category responded to requests for them to participate in the questionnaire. Policy statements regarding funding of public broadcasting could not be found for the United Australia Party nor the Informed Medical Options Party. The voting record of UAP's Craig Kelly regarding the ABC (in his previous life as a Liberal MP) was considered in the assessment process:
